Dear parents and carers,

We are already half way through the first half term and the children are well and truly settled into their new classes. We have done lots of learning and have had lots of fun!

<u>Ambassadors:</u> Congratulations to all the children who have been chosen for Ambassador roles - **ECO, Curriculum and Outdoor Ambassadors** will be working within their teams to effect changes in school and enhance the education on offer. We will keep you updated on all the exciting work that they do.

<u>Invacuation Drill:</u> Early on in the term we had a fire drill when children and staff practised what to do in the case of a fire alarm sounding. On **Thursday next week** we will be practising an **invacuation drill** where staff and children will be practising what to do in the event of an external threat. This drill will involve putting the blinds down in the classroom, locking the classroom door and sitting by a wall or under tables. You may want to talk your child through this at home. We will explain the procedure to the children before the event so they understand that it is a drill and the reasons for it.
