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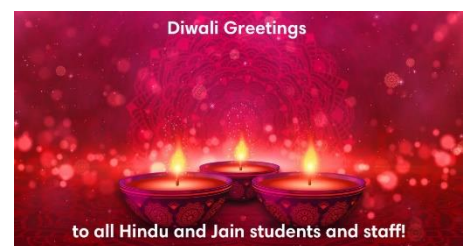
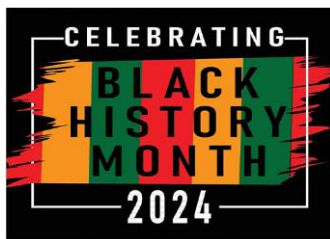
playground until all children have been registered and then they will be invited in to join pupils for a class reading session. Come and join us to find out more about different reading strategies.
