



COMMUNITY CONSULTATION

Expansion of pupil numbers and school building at Hallam Fields Primary School, Birstall, Leicester

Leicestershire County Council has identified a demand for additional primary school places locally, due to an increase in residents as a result of residential housing developments.

As an excellent primary school, recognised by Ofsted as 'an inclusive and highly ambitious school', Hallam Fields has been selected to increase its capacity.

TO ACCOMMODATE EXTRA PUPILS, LIONHEART PLANS TO:

- Build extensions to the existing school building, providing 7 further classrooms, an additional small hall and other educational and administration facilities
- Create additional parking spaces for staff and visitors

THIS MEANS:

- An increase from one to two classes per year group
- 30 extra spaces per year group* for local children to attend the school, starting with Foundation Stage class in September 2026 (expected timeline)
- A school that will offer a total of 420 pupil places by September 2032
- Further opportunity for local children to attend an excellent primary school

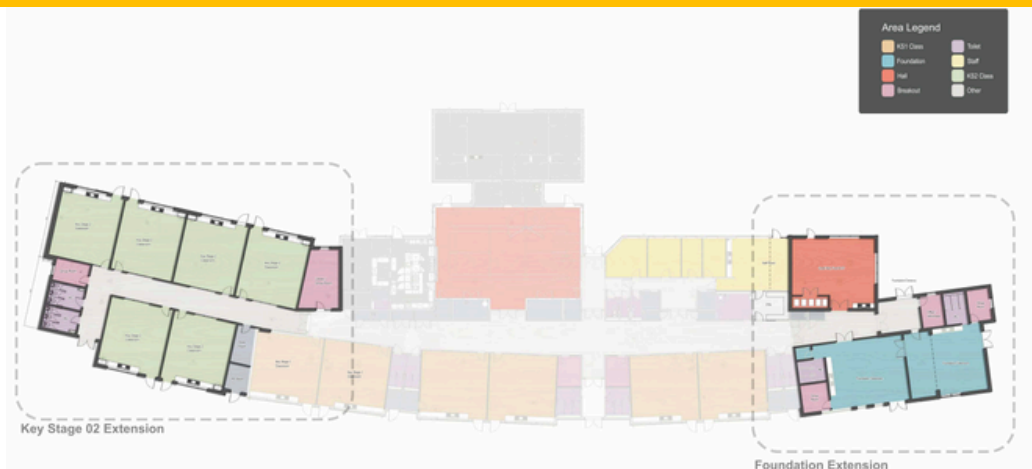
