Communication and Language

- Respond to questions
- Listen to and talk about stories
- Participate in small group, class and one to one discussion
- To use a range of social sentences eg Good morning
- To speak in full sentences

Literacy

- Enjoy listening to stories and exploring books.
- Link sounds to individual letters
- Name writing
- Make predictions

Key Vocabulary: predict, author, blurb, letter sounds

Physical Development

- Draw freely- Mark Making,
- Hold a pencil. Correct pencil grip
- Form letters accurately- letters in their names
- Develop ball skills
- Traveling in different ways

Expressive Art and Design

- Explore and experiment with a wide range of media and materials
- Safely use a range of tools (scissors, pencils, crayons, paint and paint brushes), media and techniques- hold scissors correctly, cut in a straight line
- Experiment with colour, design, texture, form and function

Understanding of the world

- Describe what they see, hear and feel whilst outside.
- Observe and notice differences in seasons.
- Draw pictures of things they notice
- Talk about lives of people around them eg their family and lives of those in wider community

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Follow instructions
- Express how they feel
- To speak to others about own needs
- To take turns in conversation and play
- To communicate with both adults and children in the setting

Maths

- Counting confidently forwards and backwards from 10.
- Subitising small quantities
- 1 more and 1 fewer

Key Vocabulary: more, fewer, subitising
