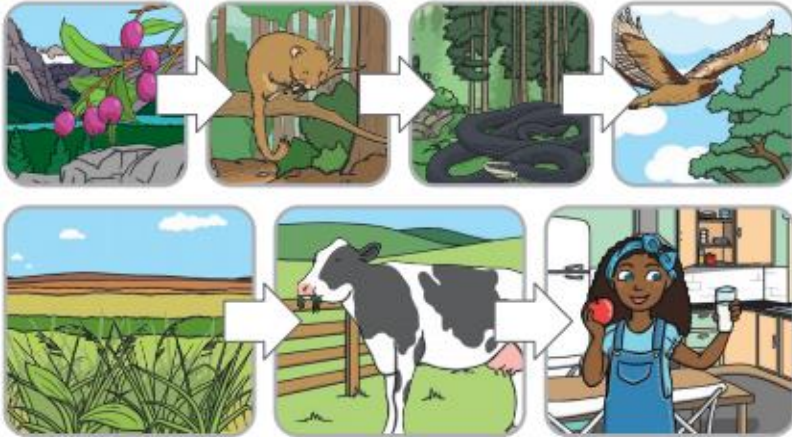


Food chains

Vocabulary

1	Life Processes	All living things have these. They move, breathe, sense, grow, make babies, get rid of waste and get their energy from food.
2	Living	Things that are living have all the life processes.
3	Dead	Things that are dead were once living. They did have the life processes, but do not now.
4	Never living	These things never had the life processes. For example metal, plastic or rock.
5	Habitat	A natural place something lives. It provides living things with everything they need to survive such as food, shelter and water.
6	Microhabitat	A very small habitat in places like under a rock, under leaves or on a branch. Minibeasts live in microhabitats.
7	Food chain	This shows how each animal get its food.
